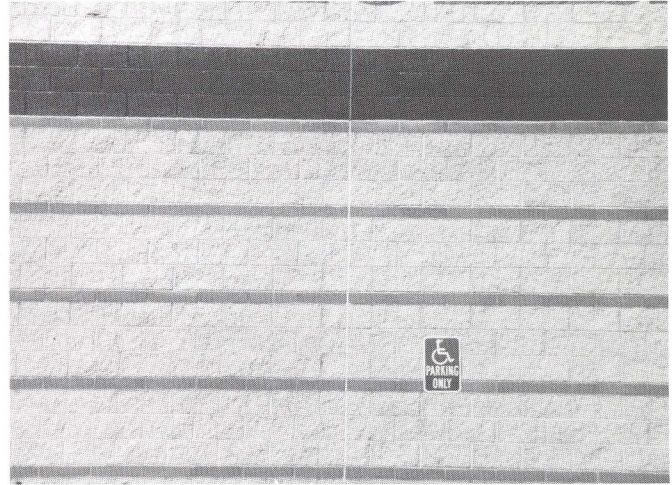
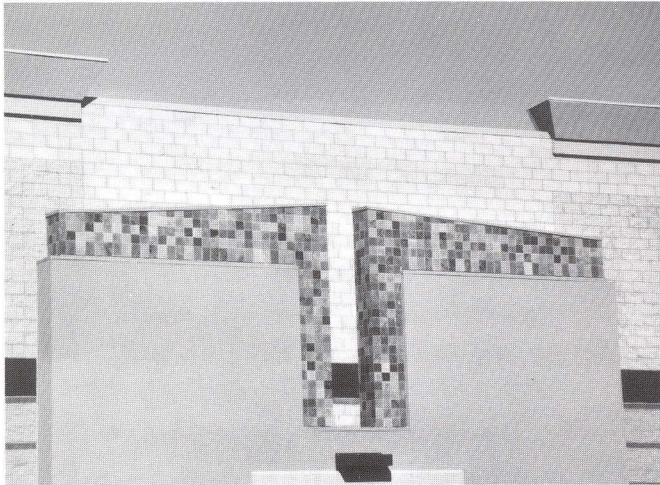

The Costco Wholesale was designed with extensive use of smooth and split face block with dry-block additive. The medium weight 10 inches walls contain an aesthetic blend at red/brown and sourdough colored units.

Additionally, the Costco theme was completed with glazed block units at the entry. One unique feature is the sourdough colored block with brown colored bands.

Most important, the owner realized that using concrete block masonry on this project enabled a fast track construction schedule.
