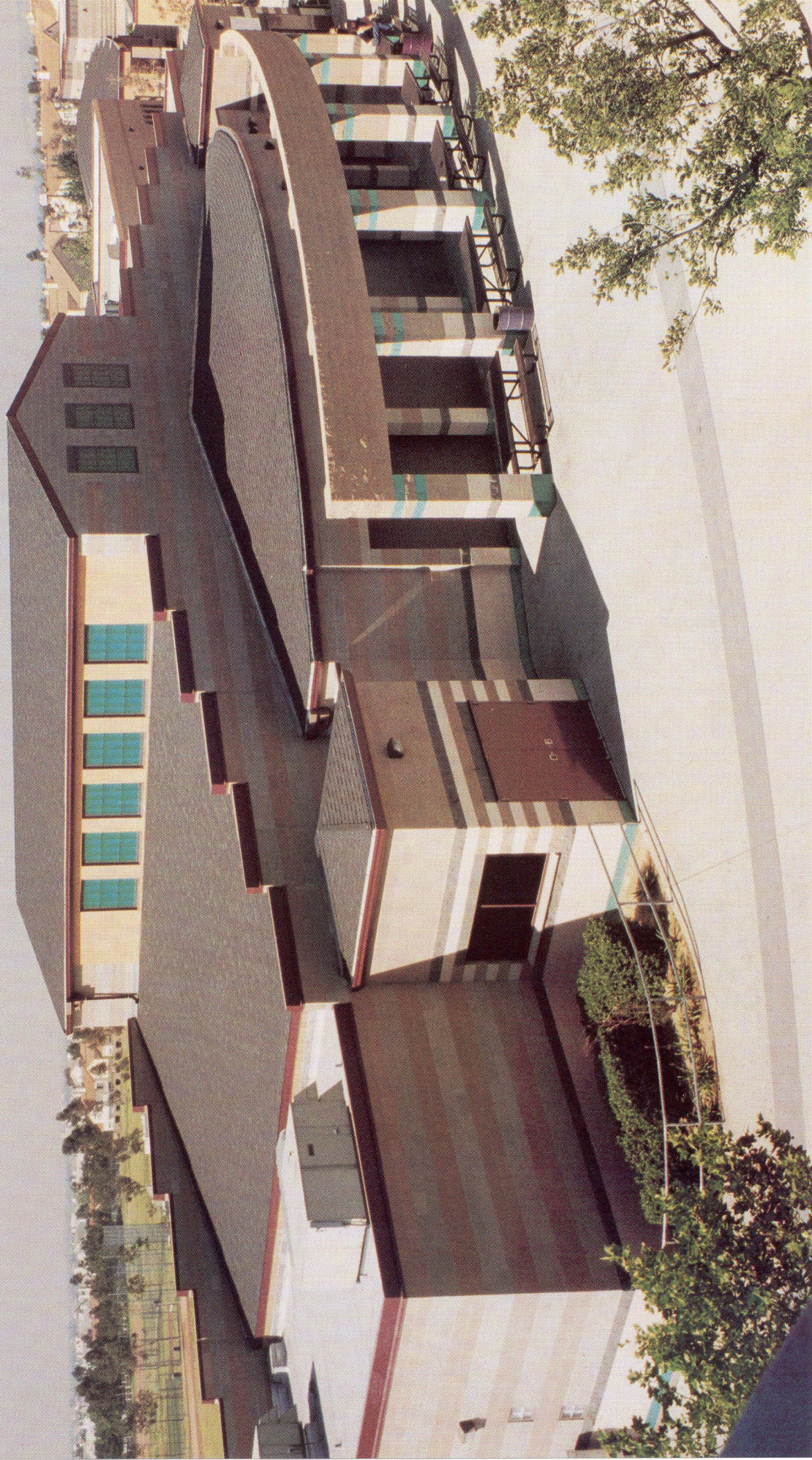
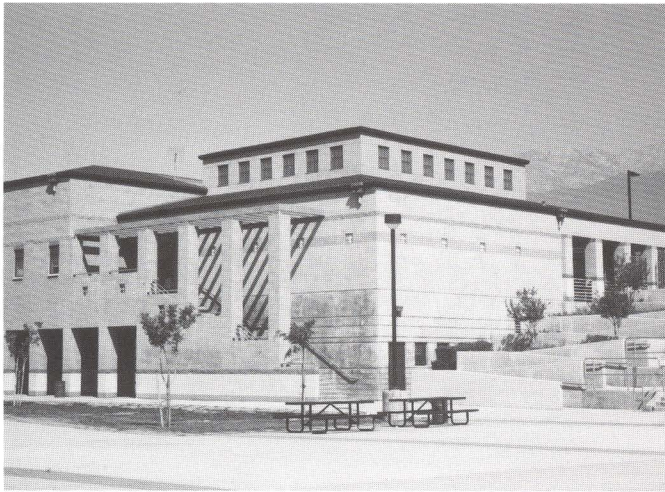

Rancho Cucamonga High School used decorative exterior masonry bearing walls with split-face and glazed banding with glass block windows providing economy and security to the school. Running bond was used for the bond patterns of masonry. Concrete masonry was chosen for the visual interest and scale it gives to the building. Cost effectiveness was also a major factor in choosing concrete masonry for this project.
