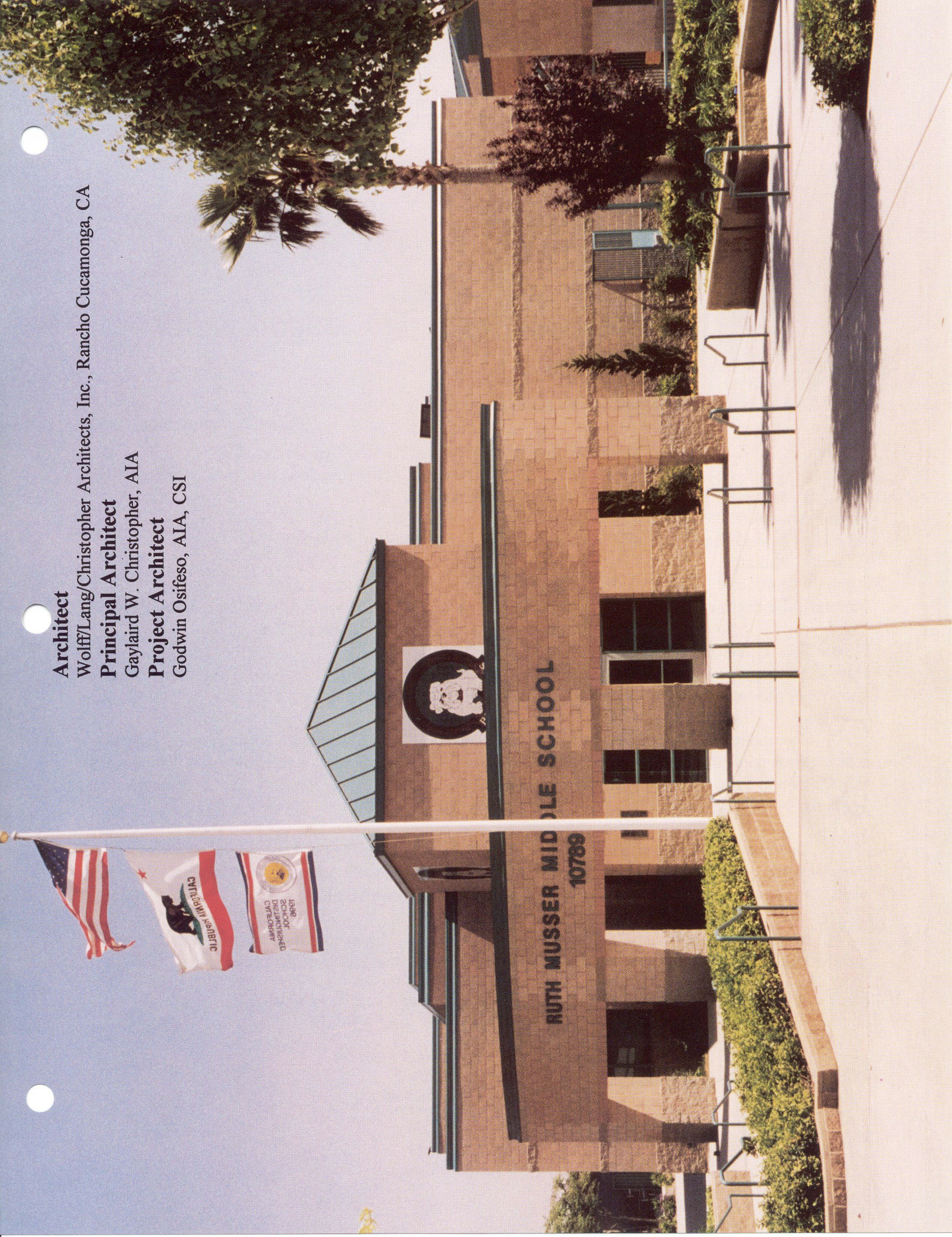

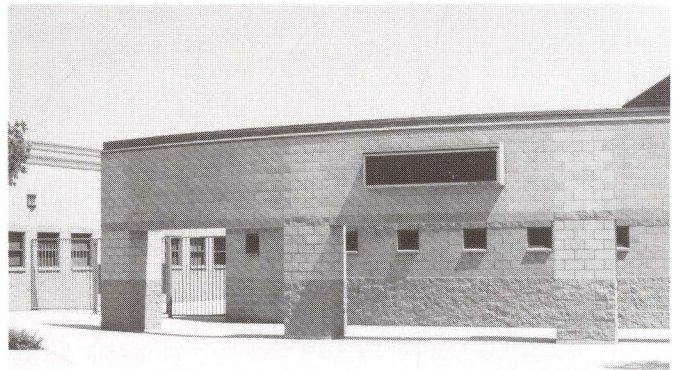

The application of colored split face and precision 8" x 16" concrete masonry units provides a simultaneous contrast of texture and color, even though the color of units is the same. To further accent the facade, a Spectra Glaze band harmoniously integrates into the masonry for a distinctive and aesthetically pleasing design.

The functional radius columns provide unique covered walkways and covered entries surrounding the structures. This enhances the topography which is a sloping site accented with integrated retaining walls. An added unique feature in this facility is a mini stadium with built in seating.

Masonry was the obvious choice for this facility. The school will benefit due to the low maintenance costs associated with masonry, will last for many years and age particularly well.
