The Sultana High School, in Hesperia California, is a facility with extensive use of gray split face 8" CMU for classroom, administration buildings and support facilities. There is a complement of precision 8" gray CMU. There is a green band of spectra glaze about 2 feet high between the 8 feet and 10 feet height.

It appears to be a variation between the split face (8" x 16") units and the single vertical scored split face units. The buildings are banded with various types of units and the vertical scored units are finished with raked joints while the split face units are finished with tooled joints.
