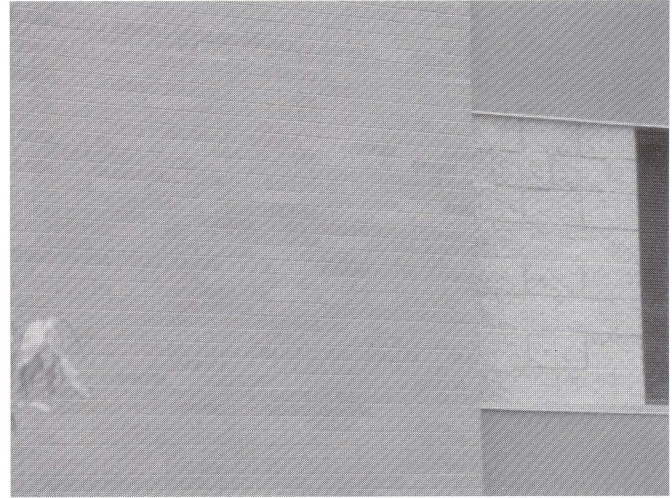

The application of brick veneer on the Fine Arts Building is a testament to humanistic concepts of architecture in which the design aesthetics enlivens the exterior environment.

The facility gives the campus a new typology that departs from the prevailing structures to an asymmetrical composition of multilevel platforms, terraces and courtyards, typical configuring while retaining the application of brick to maintain harmony of the buildings. With complementing textures and colors, all materials contribute to integrating the region's desert landscape through curvature and layered elevations.
